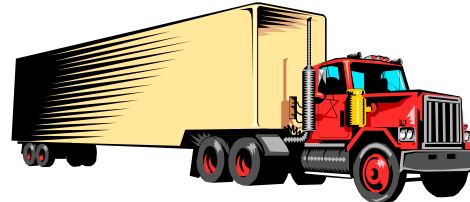


for the Community Room: \$3,000

Nice trash receptacles for the Community Room. \$150 ea

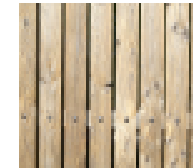


8 ft step ladder to make maintenance work easier and safer. \$150

Underwrite the cost of a privacy fence along the north side of the property: \$10,000

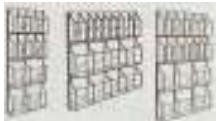

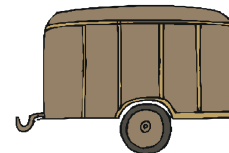
