In these cases let us be your back up. Approximately 90% of the people we serve do not attend any church.

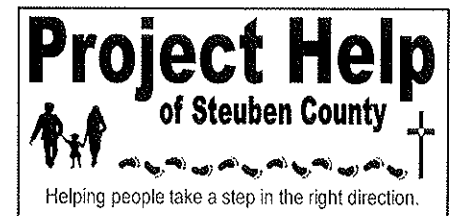

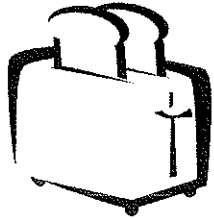
How Project Help can help your Church

If someone from the community comes to you needing clothing, household needs including

appliances, and

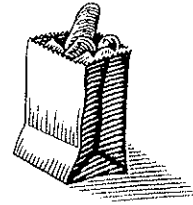
bedding, send them to us.

If someone from the community comes to your church looking for help with **food**, send them to Project Help. We can help them.



If someone from the community comes to you asking for help and you do not know where to send them to get the help they need, send them to Project Help. We can direct them to other social services agencies for the help they need.



If someone from the community comes to your church needing help with a **utility bill**, send them to us. We may be able to help them or we can put them in touch with the right agency or person to help them.

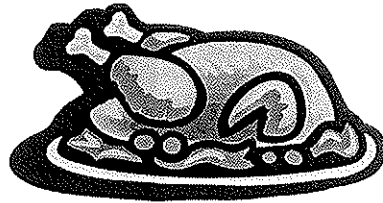


We also help with **Back to School** supplies,

If someone from the community who is uninsured or under-insured and has a medical need, send them to Project Help and we can help by sending them to a doctor or referring them to an agency for help.

Every time we help (except with clothing) we keep a record of the help so that you don't have to. We avoid duplication of services and we know who tries to "work the system".



We encourage you to let us be your **food bank**, **clothing store**, and **clearing house** for helping those who are not a part of your church. Partner with us and we can save you time and help you better serve the area's under-resourced in Christ's name.
