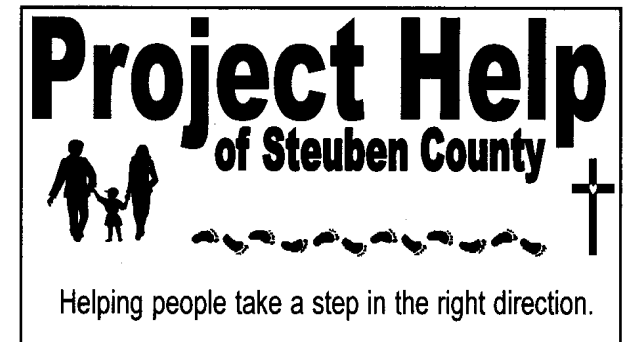

If someone from the community comes to you needing clothing,

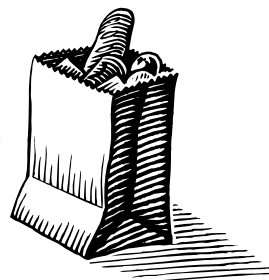


household needs including

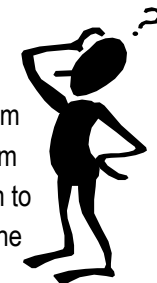
furniture, small appliances, and bedding, send them to us. We have more clothes than we can use and many other items.



If someone from the community comes to your church looking for help with **food**, send them to Project Help. We can help them during Project Help's Hours of Service (see back of this brochure for hours).

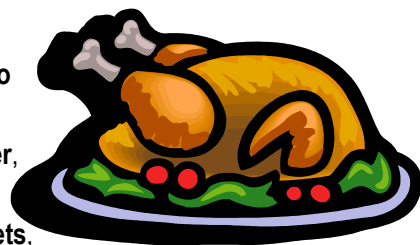


If someone from the community comes to you asking for help and you do not know where to send them to get the help they need, send them to Project Help. We can direct them to other social services agencies for the help they need.



We also help with **Back to School** supplies,

**Thanksgiving dinner, Christmas gifts, Easter dinner baskets,** and much more.



If someone from the community comes to your church needing help with a **utility bill**, send them to us. We may be able to help them or we can put them in touch with the right agency or person to help them.



We do **haircuts** at special times, such as for back to school and holidays.



If someone from the community has a medical need and is uninsured or under-insured, send them to Project Help and we can help by sending them to a clinic or by referring them to an agency for help.

Every time we help (except with clothing) we keep a record of the help to avoid duplication of services and so we know who is accessing social services in Steuben County.



We encourage you to let us be your **food pantry, clothing store, and clearing house** for helping those who are not a part of your church. Partner with us and we can save you time and help you better serve the area's under-resourced in Christ's name.
