Who can shop at the store?

The public is welcome to shop at the Second Chance Resale Store. You do not need to be a client of Project Help to shop. We welcome everyone. Bring the whole family and the neighborhood too, knowing that while you save money shopping, you help feed the community. Return daily to see new items are continually put out.

What does Project Help do with the money received through the resale store?

The goal for the store is to purchase food, cover Project Help's mortgage payment, utilities, and expenses.

Is the clothing in the store good quality?

Yes. We put name brand, clean and instyle clothing, furniture, and household items into the store. Some clothing has never been worn.

How much do things in the resale store cost?

Most clothing items are \$3.00 each piece — blue jeans, dress shirts, etc. Furniture, appliances, and household items are priced at resale cost.

Is there more than just clothing in the store?

Yes. There is furniture, household items, toys, books, etc. as they are available but mostly it is clothing.

What sizes of clothing are in the store?

All sizes from infant to 5XL. We have something for everyone.

Who runs the store?

We have a part time employee as store manager and volunteers work in the store. There are volunteers who sort the clothing and stock the store. Call Sheri at 665-9697 to volunteer.

What forms of payment do you accept?

Purchases must be made in cash or by check. We do not accept credit cards or debit cards.

If I donate clothing may I take clothing in trade?

Sorry, we are not able to trade clothing but any client can register for services. Please speak with a Project Help staff person if you have needs.

May I return items I have purchased?

Sorry, all sales are final. No returns will be allowed unless a defect is discovered after purchase.

Are fitting rooms available so I can try on clothing?

Yes, there are fitting rooms available for your use.

May I put something in layaway or put a hold on it?

Only large items may be held and only for up to 24 hours. No holds on clothing or other items.

What are the store hours?

The store is open Monday through Friday, 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. and on Saturdays, 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Closed Sunday.
